Getting Started with the Data Security and Protection Toolkit (DSPT)




What is the DSPT? (1)

The Data Security and Protection Toolkit is an online self-assessment tool that allows organisations to measure their performance against the National Data Guardian's 10 data security standards. It is an annual assessment.

As data security standards evolve, the requirements of the DSPT are reviewed and updated to ensure they are aligned with current best practice.

Organisations with access to NHS patient data must therefore review and submit their annual assessment each year before the deadline.



What is the DSPT? (2)

All organisations that have access to NHS patient data and systems must use this toolkit to provide assurance that they are practising good data security and that personal information is handled correctly.


There are various levels of compliance that an organisation can publish at, however 'Standards Met' is the desired level to allow data sharing with the NHS.



Why should I complete the DSPT?

Completing the DSPT enables care organisations to demonstrate that they have appropriate systems and policies in place to safeguard people's information.

It also enables care provider organisations to access additional NHS services such as NHS Mail, GP Proxy for ordering medications, and GP Connect which enables access to GP patient records making information sharing for care delivery safer and more efficient.



What do I need to get started?

To complete the DSPT self – assessment, you will need to register your organisation via this link:
